

# Apply with abbreviated underwriting during the FLTCIP Open Season: April 4 through June 24, 2011.

The Federal Long Term Care Insurance Program (FLTCIP) Open Season is from April 4 through June 24, 2011. This is the first abbreviated underwriting opportunity for non-enrolled applicants since 2002.

# **Eligibility**

Abbreviated underwriting (applicants answer fewer health questions) is available for actively at work Federal and U.S. Postal Service employees (civilian workforce members) and their spouses/same-sex domestic partners and active members of the uniformed services and their spouses. Non-enrolled annuitants and other qualified relatives can apply for coverage at any time, but must complete a full underwriting application.

# Important considerations

- Long term care is the care you need if you cannot perform activities of daily living (such as bathing or dressing) on your own.
