Our office has reviewed the employee's military records and certified that the employee is entitled to concurrent civil service retirement pay and military retirement pay for non-regular service, under Chapter 1223 of Title 10 (i.e., 10 U.S.C.§§ 12731-12741), the pension system applicable to Reservist or state National Guard duty. Service time used as the basis for a non-regular military pension may be creditable toward U.S. Federal Government civilian retirement under either of the following sections (check one):

- □ Federal Employees' Retirement System (FERS), 5 U.S.C. § 8411(c)(2)(b), or Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS), 5 U.S.C. § 8332(c)(2)(B).
- \Box Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS), 5 U.S.C. § 8332(c)(2)(B).
